<p>1. WAR MEMORIAL GARDEN, WOOLLEY Conveyed to ownership by the Parish Council and registered by West Riding of Yorkshire, Registry of Deeds on 23 September 1969. Restrictions: The area described as some 450 sq yards to be held for the purposes of a War Memorial.</p> <p>Monetary Value:</p>	<p>£2,500</p>
<p>2. LAND AT HAIGH This land, some 230 sq yards in total, was the site of a YEB station which had become badly neglected. It was purchased by the Parish Council for the sum of £200, "to enhance the area and be of use to parishioners". The Transfer deed was duly registered on 25 July 1997. VILLAGE HALL Purchased by the Parish Council from Wakefield Metropolitan District Council and transfer Deed dated 24 December 1993 but subject to covenants contained in clause 11 which restrict its use to a community social and RECHAR centre for the residents of Woolley aforesaid and the neighbourhood thereof. The property is held on trust for the purpose of a village hall for the use of the inhabitants of the Civil Parish of Woolley. Disposal is subject to legislative requirements and the provisions of the governing instrument of the charity. Valuation by Wilby's Barnsley, September 2012.</p>	<p>£275,000 (insurance valuation 14.9.12)</p>
<p>4. RECREATION GROUND Gifted to the Village purely for use as a Recreation ground for the children of Woolley</p>	<p>£25,000</p>
